Within nearly every person, there is disappointment of some kind.

GOING DEEPER: “LORD, I WANT TO TRUST YOU, NO MATTER WHAT THE OUTCOME.”

Often, for God, the journey and the process toward the fulfillment of the dream is more important than the actual fulfillment.

GOING DEEPER: “LORD, HELP ME MAKE THIS DISAPPOINTMENT THE BEGINNING OF SOMETHING NEW THAT WILL HONOR YOU.”

Paul dreamed of going to Spain. Instead, he landed in a Roman prison (Romans 15:24, Philippians 1:12)

Pivotal praying avoids trivial, self-motivation, controlling, or manipulative prayers.

GOING DEEPER: “LORD, HELP ME REMEMBER MY LIFE IS NOT ABOUT JUST ME.”

David affirmed his commitment to follow whatever God wanted, whenever He wanted it.

It is pivotal praying when we offer our lives, desires, and dreams in a spirit of surrender.

When our dreams don’t come true, *we* need to adjust instead of asking *God* to.
