Encouragement is the language of the New Testament.

Barnabas name means “son of encouragement.”

A balcony person is an encourager and cheerleader.

BARNABAS WAS A BALCONY PERSON BY GIVING.

Joseph, a Levite from Cyprus whom the apostles called Barnabas, sold a field he owned and brought the money and put it at the apostles' feet. Acts 4:36

BARNABAS WAS A BALCONY PERSON BY SHOWING GRACE.

But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles. He told them how Saul on his journey had seen the Lord and that the Lord had spoken to him, and how in Damascus he had preached fearlessly in the name of Jesus. Acts 9:27

BARNABAS WAS A BALCONY PERSON BY SERVING.

BARNABAS WAS A BALCONY PERSON BY DEVELOPING OTHERS.

Barnabas wanted to take John, also called Mark, with them. But Paul did not think it was wise because he had deserted them... Acts 15:38

WE NEED TO BE BALCONY PEOPLE FOR EACH OTHER.
