

**The Upper Room
Pentecost Sunday
June 5, 2022**

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. ²Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. ⁴All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. Acts 2:1-4

Pentecost Prime People are...

- **PEOPLE OF THE UPPER ROOM**

When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. Acts 2:1

... they all joined together constantly in prayer... Acts 1:14

Something happens when we gather as a church that will not happen when we are not together.

...they went to the upper room - upstairs room of the house where they were staying. Acts 1:13

The same room where they had the Last Supper is the same room where the Holy Spirit descended

When the Holy Spirit descended 2000 years ago, He filled the same identical room where Jesus had fellowship and communion in the presence of betrayal and denial.

...the same Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you. Romans 8:11

- **PENTECOST PRIME ARE PEOPLE WHO WAIT AND QUALIFY FOR “SUDDENLY’S.”**

Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven. Acts 2:2

- **PENTECOST PRIME ARE PEOPLE OF FIRE**

Then what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability. Acts 2:3-4

Israelite people led the Israelite people through the wilderness with a cloud by day and a *pillar of fire* by night.

- **PENTECOST PRIME ARE PEOPLE WHO SPEAK THE LANGUAGE OF THE SPIRIT**

All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them... Acts 2:4

Pentecost prime people hear a sound to make a sound.

Where there is a spirit of expectancy, people open up to God.
