- •Proverbs 21:1 The king's heart is *like* channels of water in the hand of the LORD; He turns it wherever He wishes.
- *2 Chronicles 20:5-9 Then Jehoshaphat stood in the assembly of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD before the new court, and he said, "O LORD, the God of our fathers, are You not God in the heavens? And are You not ruler over all the kingdoms of the nations? Power and might are in Your hand so that no one can stand against You. Did You not, O our God, drive out the inhabitants of this land before Your people Israel and give it to the descendants of Abraham Your friend forever? They have lived in it, and have built You a sanctuary there for Your name, saying, 'Should evil come upon us, the sword, or judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we will stand before this house and before You (for Your name is in this house) and cry to You in our distress, and You will hear and deliver us.

- •Isaiah 44:28 "It is I who says of Cyrus, 'He is My shepherd! And he will perform all My desire.' And he declares of Jerusalem, 'She will be built,' And of the temple, 'Your foundation will be laid."
- •Isaiah 45:1-4 Thus says the LORD to Cyrus His anointed, whom I have taken by the right hand, to subdue nations before him and to loose the loins of kings; to open doors before him so that gates will not be shut: "I will go before you and make the rough places smooth; I will shatter the and cut through their iron bars. I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden wealth of secret places, So that you may know that it is I, The LORD, the God of Israel, who calls you by your name. For the sake of Jacob My servant, and Israel My chosen one, I have also called you by your name; I have given you a title of honor though you have not known Me

WHAT ACTUALLY HAPPENED

- •Cyrus, a Persian, conquered Babylon with barely a fight
- Nabonidus, the Babylonian king, was in Saudi Arabia worshiping the moon god at Tayma for several years
- His son, Belshazzar, was reigning in his place
- •Ezra 1:1-3 Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, in order to fulfill the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, so that he sent a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and also put it in writing, saying: Thus says Cyrus king of Persia, 'The LORD, the God of heaven, has given me all the kingdoms of the earth and He has appointed me to build Him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Whoever there is among you of all His people, may his God be with? him! Let him go up to Jerusalem which is in Judah and rebuild the house of the LORD, the God of Israel; He is the God who is in Jerusalem

THE CYRUS CYLINDER



The Cyrus Cylinder makes is clear that Cyrus was not a worshiper of the Jewish God; He was Zoroastrian and worshiped Ahuramazda

- Question: was Cyrus aware of the fact that God was in charge of what was happening?
- •Were the Moabites, Ammonites, and Meunites aware?
- Were the people of Egypt aware of the fact that God was in control of their gifts to the Israelites?
- •When we watch the news, are we seeing God's hand?

HOW DOES GOD LEAD?

- *Matthew 2:13-15 Now when they had gone, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream and said, "Get up! Take the Child and His mother and flee to Egypt, and remain there until I tell you; for Herod is going to search for the Child to destroy Him." So Joseph got up and took the Child and His mother while it was still night, and left for Egypt. He remained there until the death of Herod. This was to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet: "OUT OF EGYPT I CALLED MY SON."
- •Acts 4:29-31 "And now, Lord, take note of their threats, and grant that Your bond-servants may speak Your word with all confidence, while You extend Your hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Your holy servant Jesus." And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak

SOVEREIGN OVER LEADERS?

- •Romans 13:1-2 Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God. There-fore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.
- •Authority: exousia: governing domain; given to ruler by someone else; rules of operation by the one granting
- •Established: tasso: appointed or designated
- •1 Timothy 2:1-4 First of all, then, I urge that entreaties and prayers, petitions and thanksgivings, be made on behalf of all men, for kings and all who are in authority, so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life in all godliness and dignity. This is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to

MOT ONLY WHO, BUT WHEN AND

- •Isaiah 40:23-25 He *it is* who reduces rulers to nothing, Who makes the judges of the earth meaningless. Scarcely have they been planted, scarcely have they been sown, scarcely has their stock taken root in the earth, but He merely blows on them, and they wither, and the storm carries them away like stubble. To whom then will you liken Me That I would be *his* equal?" says the Holy One.
- Proverbs 21:31 The horse is prepared for the day of battle, but victory belongs to the LORD.
- •Judges 7:2 The LORD said to Gideon, "The people who are with you are too many for Me to give Midian into their hands, for Israel would become boastful, saying, 'My own power has delivered me.'

- •Creating: bara: producing
- •Causing: asah: bringing about, accomplishing
- Calamity: ra: distress, misery
- Egyptians in the Red Sea: miracle for Israel; calamity for Egypt
- •Jericho: miracle for Israel; calamity for those in Jericho
