Luke 23:32-33, 38-43

Two thieves were sentenced to die at the same time, the same day as Jesus, and they were each crucified next to Him.

We must not delay our conversion for God is not mocked.

Three questions to answer to become secure and sure with God:

FIRST QUESTION ... DO YOU _____ YOUR NEED?
