

ACTS 2:1-4

When the day of Pentecost had arrived, they were all together in one place. ² Suddenly a sound like that of a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were staying. ³ They saw tongues like flames of fire that separated and rested on each one of them. ⁴ Then they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them.

ACTS 1

Jesus commands the disciples to *Wait* in Jerusalem for the *Promise*.



HABAKKUK 2:3

"Though it delays, wait for it, since it will certainly come and not be late."

2 PETER 3:9

"The Lord does not delay his promise, as some understand delay, but is patient with you, not wanting any to perish but all to come to repentance."

ACTS 1

The Disciples <u>Obeyed</u>, they were in <u>Unity</u> and they <u>Prayed</u> together.

PENTECOST

- Feast of the ingathering, Feast of First Fruits, Feast of Weeks...
- Pentecost = 50th

WHAT PENTECOST MEANT

- Feast of the Ingathering, Feast of First Fruits, Feast of Weeks...
- Pentecost = 50th
- Served as a reminder of deliverance from Egypt

JESUS FULFILLS PENTECOST

- Passover Lamb (1 Corinthians 5:7, Revelation 5:6)
- Blood above the door (Matthew 26:28)
- Red Sea (1 John 3:14)
- First Fruits of New Creation (1 Corinthians 15:20)
- Deliverer (John 8:36, Galatians 5:1, Acts 4:12)
- <u>Ascension</u> into heaven and then the coming down of the Holy Spirit connected with Moses <u>ascending</u> Mount Sanai and then coming down with the Law, or the word of God (Acts 1, Exodus 24:12-18)

JESUS FULFILLS PENTECOST

- Jesus taught for 40 Days about the Kingdom + 10 days the Disciples were in the upper room. (50 days total)
- 50 days between the Resurrection and the Promise.
- 50 days between Passover and Pentecost.
- 50 days between The Exodus and receiving the Law

JOHN 3:8

"The wind blows where it pleases, and you hear its **sound**, but you don't know where it comes from or where it is going. So, it is with everyone born of the **Spirit**."

"I baptize you with water for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is more powerful than I. I am not worthy to remove his sandals. He himself will baptize you with the *Holy Spirit* and *fire*."
