Being a Vessel of Honor in God’s House!

God’s House functions in all aspects. So, if each member of His household is truly thankful and devoted because of the privilege of being HIS, then each member will strive to walk in integrity and honor. There are duties that help the House to operate well. But in this scripture reference, The Word defines what God’s will is in those functions for every part of His Household. The key is for each part to do their very best, set aside and fully sanctified in faith-trusting, accomplishing the most high-quality outcome for His purposes.

2 Timothy 2:20-21 (AMPC) ²⁰ But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and silver, but also [utensils] of wood and earthenware, and some for honorable *and* noble [use] and some for menial *and* ignoble [use]. ²¹ So whoever cleanses himself [from what is ignoble *and* unclean, who separates himself from contact with contaminating and corrupting influences] will [then himself] be a vessel set apart *and* useful for honorable *and* noble purposes, consecrated *and* profitable to the Master, fit *and* ready for any good work.

Notice the emphasis on verse 21-Underlined for your benefit.

2 Timothy 2:20-21 (MSG) ²⁰⁻²¹ In a well-furnished kitchen there are not only crystal goblets and silver platters, but waste cans and compost buckets—some containers used to serve fine meals, others to take out the garbage. Become the kind of container God can use to present any and every kind of gift to his guests for their blessing.

2 Timothy 2:20-21 (TPT) In a palace you find many kinds of containers and tableware for many different uses. Some are beautifully inlaid with gold or silver, but some are made of wood or earthenware; some of them are used for banquets and special occasions, and some for everyday use. But you, Timothy, must not see your life and ministry this way. Your life and ministry must not be disgraced, for you are to be a pure container of Christ and dedicated to the honorable purposes of your Master, prepared for every good work that he gives you to do.

1 John 4:19 (NKJV) ¹⁹ We love ^[a]Him because He first loved us.

1 Peter 4:8 (NLT) ⁸ Most important of all, continue to show deep love for each other, for love covers a multitude of sins.

1 Corinthians 13:8a (AMPC) ⁸ Love never fails [never fades out or becomes obsolete or comes to an end].

Confession and Prayer:

“Lord, because of Your sacrifice and victory, I desire to be one of those containers that flows Your perfect Love. I desire that Your fruits are evident in, on, and through me! I commit myself again today, and every day to continue to grow into a vessel of HONOR for Your sake and for Your cause! I listen for Your leading and guidance, Your instructions and corrections, and Your Holy promptings every minute of every day!
