

# **Elder Abilities / Qualifications**


#### "Holding fast the faithful word which is in according with THE teaching"

#### **Elder Command**


#### "Reprove them severely"

# **Older Women**


"Reverent, not malicious gossips, not enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good"

"Love their husbands and children, sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands"




"the word of God will not be dishonored"

Titus' example: "Good deeds, doctrinal purity, sound speech"




"the opponent will be put to shame, having nothing bad to say about us"

Subject to own masters


- Not pilfering

#### Titus 3:1-2

<sup>1</sup> Remind them to be submissive to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good work, <sup>2</sup> to malign no one, to be peaceable, gentle, showing every consideration for all men.

# Acts 5:27-29

<sup>27</sup> When they had brought them, they stood them before the Council. The high priest questioned them, <sup>28</sup> saying, "We gave you strict orders not to continue teaching in this name, and yet you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and intend to bring this man's blood upon us." <sup>29</sup> But Peter and the apostles answered, "We must obey God rather than men."



# Q: What do we do when there's a conflict?


# **Some Principles from Daniel**

- Normal course of action --> obey authority
- Resist when obedience violates word of God
- If possible, work out a suitable accommodation
- If disobedience is called for, we should still show respect

# **More Reminders**

"<sup>2</sup> to malign no one, <u>to be</u> peaceable, gentle, showing every consideration for all men"

- "Consideration" courtesy
- In Greek culture, "consideration" was often laughed at. It was seen as fake, hypocritical and as a false concern for someone else, driven by self-interest.

# The Instructions

- Subject ourselves to rulers
- To be obedient
- To be ready for every good deed
- To malign no one
- To be peaceable
- Gentle
- Showing consideration for all men

# The Rationale

<sup>3</sup> For we also once were foolish ourselves, disobedient, deceived, enslaved to various lusts and pleasures, spending our life in malice and envy, hateful, hating one another. <sup>4</sup> But when the kindness of God our Savior and His love for mankind appeared, <sup>5</sup> He saved us, not on the basis of deeds which we have done...

# The Rationale

... in righteousness, but according to His mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom He poured out upon us richly through Jesus Christ our Savior, <sup>7</sup> so that being justified by His grace we would be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.



# HE SAVED US

#### **Rationale for Salvation**

By His kindness, mercy, regeneration, and renewing by the Spirit, He saved us [and justified us]



"We would be made heirs"

# **Roman Emperors**


- Claudius (41-54) expelled Jews from Rome
- ABOPTED
  Nero (54-68) despised
  Christians; blamed them for his
  - own terrible choices; burned them to provide light for his garden

# Romans 8:15

<sup>15</sup> For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!"

# Galatians 4:4-5

<sup>4</sup> But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, <sup>5</sup> to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.



# Roman Adoption Law

- The adopted son had a position better than the natural son
- A full heir, irreversible, legally severed from any prior sonship
- The adopted son lost all rights in his old family & gained all the rights of a fully legitimate son in his new family

# Roman Adoption Law

- He became an heir to his new father's estate, even if other sons were born afterwards
- The old life of the adopted son was completely wiped out, so that he was regarded as a new person entering into a new life

# Galatians 4:4-7

<sup>4</sup> But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, <sup>5</sup> to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. <sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" <sup>7</sup> So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

# Romans 8:15-17

<sup>15</sup> For you have not received a spirit of slavery leading to fear again, but you have received a spirit of adoption as sons by which we cry out, "Abba! Father!" <sup>16</sup> The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are children of God, <sup>17</sup> and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him so that we may also be glorified with Him.

#### Titus 3:8-14

<sup>8</sup> This is a trustworthy statement; and concerning these things I want you to speak confidently, so that those who have believed in God will be careful to engage in good deeds. These things are good and profitable for men. <sup>9</sup> But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and strife and disputes about the Law, for they are unprofitable and worthless.

## Titus 3:8-14

<sup>10</sup> As for a person who stirs up division, after warning him once and then twice, having nothing to do with him, <sup>11</sup> knowing that such a person is warped and sinful; he is self-condemned. <sup>12</sup> When I send Artemas or Tychicus to you, make every effort to come to me at Nicopolis, for I have decided to spend the winter there. <sup>13</sup> Diligently help Zenas the lawyer and...

... Apollos on their way so that nothing is lacking for them. <sup>14</sup> Our people must also learn to engage in good deeds to meet pressing needs, so that they will not be unfruitful. <sup>15</sup> All who are with me greet you. Greet those who love us in the faith. Grace be with you all.


#### **Foolish Controversies**



## 1 Corinthians 1:28-31




