### Held Captive

Galatians 3:23 "...we were held captive under the law, imprisoned until the coming faith would be revealed.



Romans 7:6 "But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive..."

### Law: IMPRISONED

### Grace: FREE



### Titus 2:15

<sup>15</sup> These things speak and exhort and reprove with all authority. Let no one disregard you.

- -Speak: "give the information"
- -Exhort: "act on that information"
- -Reprove: "you haven't, so get with it!"
- -Titus was given all authority

### **Roman Emperors**

- Caligula (37-41) thought he was God and actively sought worship.
  Set up his own image in the temple as God.
- Claudius (41-54) expelled Jews from Rome

 Nero (54-68) – despised Christians; blamed them for his own terrible choices; burned them to provide light for his garden





## Romans 13:1-7

<sup>1</sup> Every person is to be in subjection to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those which exist are established by God.<sup>2</sup> Therefore whoever resists authority has opposed the ordinance of God; and they who have opposed will receive condemnation upon themselves.<sup>3</sup> For rulers are not a...

## Romans 13:1-7

...cause of fear for good behavior, but for evil. Do you want to have no fear of authority? Do what is good and you will have praise from the same; <sup>4</sup> for it is a minister of God to you for good. But if you do what is evil, be afraid; for it does not bear the sword for nothing; for it is a minister of God, an avenger who brings wrath on the one who practices evil.

#### Romans 13:1-7

<sup>5</sup> Therefore it is necessary to be in subjection, not only because of wrath but also for conscience' sake.

## 1 Peter 2:13-17

<sup>13</sup> Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every human institution, whether to a king as the one in authority, <sup>14</sup> or to governors as sent by him for the punishment of evildoers and the praise of those who do right. <sup>15</sup> For such is the will of God that by doing right you may silence the ignorance of foolish men.

#### 1 Peter 2:13-17

<sup>16</sup> *Act* as free men, and do not use your freedom as a covering for evil, but *use it* as bondslaves of God. <sup>17</sup> Honor all people, love the brotherhood, fear God, honor the king.
