Four Types of Finishers:

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| ☐ Cut off early. | 1 Samuel 16:14; Acts 5:1-11 |
| ☐ Finished poorly. | 1 Kings 1-43; 2 Timothy 4:10 |
| ☐ Finished so-so. | 2 Samuel 12:1-25; 2 Kings 20:1-21 |
| ☐ Finished well. | Daniel 1:1-21; 2 Timothy 4:6-8 |

THE BLESSING: Every Christian can finish well by embracing the lifestyle of the Apostle Paul.

Lifestyle #1: Finishing well requires sacrifice.

2 Timothy 4:6; Numbers 15:1-10; Luke 9:23;
Philippians 2:17; Romans 12:1-2

Lifestyle #2: Finishing well requires perseverance.

2 Timothy 4:7; Romans 8:29-30; Philippians 1:6;
Hebrews 12:1-4; 1 Peter 1:3-5

Lifestyle #3: Finishing well requires an eternal perspective.

2 Timothy 4:8; Matthew 25:21; Philippians 1:23; 3:20;
2 Corinthians 5:1-8
