- ⇒ Worship is a verb. Meaning, there is always action involved in worship, no matter what worship looks like or is defined as.
- \Rightarrow Following the Star was an act of worship because the star that guided the magi gave glory to God.

The Moon	1 1/3 sec
The Sun	8 minutes
Jupiter	35 to 52 minutes
Pluto	5 1/2 hours (on average)
Alpha Centauri (nearest star system)	4.3 years
Sirius (brightest star in our sky)	9 years
Betelgeuse (bright star)	430 years
Orion Nebula	1500 years
Andromeda Galaxy	2.5 million years

- \Rightarrow Beneath the star there was worship of Jesus Christ.
- \Rightarrow Beneath the star on our tree there should be worship of Jesus Christ.
