Question: Where will I be 100 years from now? Answer: As a believer in Jesus, I'll be in Heaven! **Question:** What will heaven be like? Answers:

1. In heaven we will not: (Rev 21:1-25; 22:3-5)

• Feel sorrow (21:4)

• Feel pain (21:4)

• Feel alone (21:22)

• Feel insecure (21:25)

• Feel needy (22:1-2)

• Feel cursed (22:3-5)

• Feel unimportant (22:3-5)

2. In heaven we will be like Jesus: (Phil 3:20-21)

- We will be recognizable. (Matt 28:9)
- We will be relational. (John 21:15-17)
- We will be touchable. (Luke 24:39)
- We will eat and drink. (Luke 24:42-43)
- We will transcend space and gravity. (Jn 20:19; Lk 24:36, 51)
- We will talk with angels. (Rev 21:15)
- We will be in paradise! (Luke 23:43)

3. In heaven we will receive <u>rewards</u>: (Matthew 6:19-20)

We are storing up our heavenly treasure.

(Mt 19:21, 29; 25:21, 23; Luke 12:33; 16:9; 18:22;

1 Cor 3:8; Phil 4:17; Col 3:23-24; 1 Tim 6:19; Rev 22:12)

- We will each have different levels of treasure. (1 Cor 3:14)
- Remember the widow's mite (Luke 21:1-4)!
- This is why we long for riches on earth:
 - We were designed for eternal, unimaginable treasure!
 - The enemy seeks to destroy us and trick us to invest mostly on earth rather than in heaven!
 - How we live today determines our rewards forever!
