- ⇒ Is truth found in the Bible and in the words of Christ, or is truth found outside of scripture with the scientists, philosophers, societies, and other religions the world has to offer?
- ⇒ The Bible is counter-cultural because humanity and nearly every culture has been in rebellion against God in every era outside of Eden.
- ⇒ One of the main driving forces of the deconstruction movement—as well as one of the common reasons a person might doubt or deconstruct what they believe, is the message of the Bible versus the message of the culture, and whichever one is really the truth.
- ⇒ Moral relativism is the idea that there are no absolute rules to determine if anything is right or wrong.
