Strong's number: 3807 παιδαγωγός (paidagogos) aka pedagogue

- ⇒ To make matters simple the law condemned sin and secondly supervised the lives of God's people until they arrived to the real teacher.
- ⇒ With the coming of Christ the supervisory role of the law ended, just as the role of a pedagogue ended once the boy he was in charge of came of age.
