- 1. God is shaping my destiny, even when I can't see it. (1-5)
 - "I have chosen." (1; see also Eph 1:4)
- 2. God thinks I'm special, even though others don't notice me. (6-10)
 - "Man looks at <u>outward</u> appearances." (7; See Psm 139:13-16)
- 3. God cares more about my heart than my looks or pedigree. (11-13)
 - "But the Lord looks on the heart." (7; Psm 51:10)
- 4. God trains us for our destiny by asking us to serve first. (11-23)
 - "He is with the sheep." (19, Eph 2:10)
- 5. God is preparing our ultimate destiny in heaven. (John 14:1-6)
