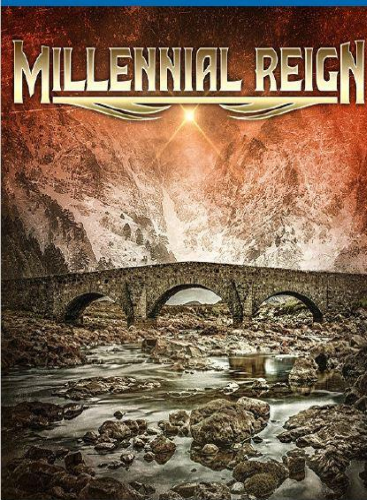


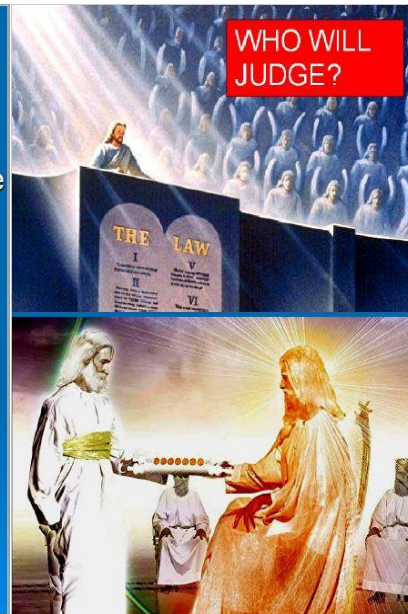
## Lesson #46 Revelation: 20:11-end

- Much damage to our planet from war and God's judgments
- Many corpses to bury

WHO WILL JUDGE?

- Revelation 20:11 – 15
- Great White Throne judgment
- “The One” and “The Ancient One” are OT names for the Father
- When Son & Father are together, the Father is seated on the throne
- Rev. 5:1-5, 19:4 – 5
- John 5:19 – 29
- Here we find Christ judging

- Father and Son are different attributes of the same God
- John 1:1 – 3
- God and Yeshua are doing the task of judging together
- It is the Father sitting on the throne
- It is one thing to be seated on the throne, but that is not needed to judge

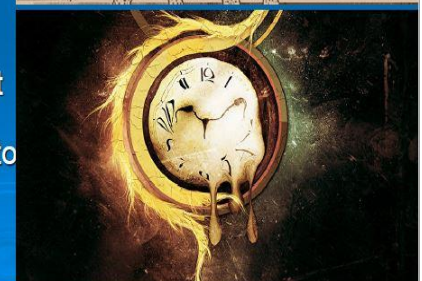
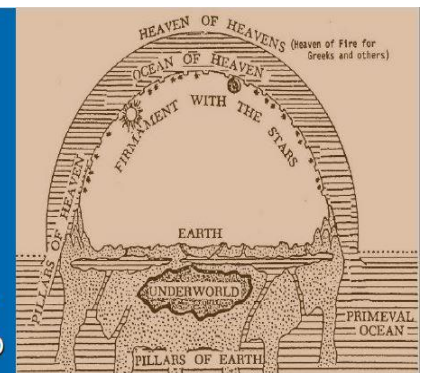
### THE SON AS THE FATHER'S AGENT



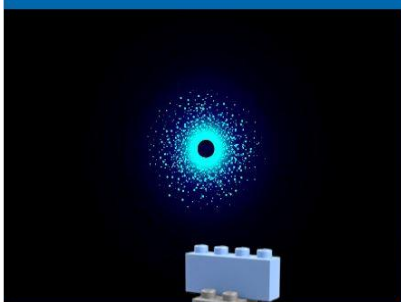

### EARTH AND HEAVEN FLEE

- Biblically, in ancient times “heaven”, “heavens”, and “mid-heaven” were interchangeable terms
- God's goal has been to redeem, restore, and perfect His Creation
- John is speaking about the disappearance or return of the Universe to it's original state of nothingness



### WILL THE UNIVERSE REVERSE?

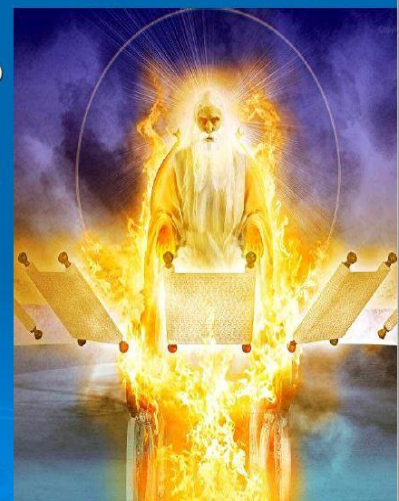


- Science says that all energy and matter have come from one tiny point, long ago
- It suddenly expanded (the Big Bang) and grew into the Universe
- Vs. 11 seems like a reversal of the process
- Everything is reduced and compressed back to the beginning
- Later, to start chapter 21, it is put back together differently

- At the end of the Millennium the rest of the dead are raised
- Rev. 20:5
- These are Believers who as regular humans died during the 1000 years, and also all others, good or evil, who have ever lived
- Romans 14:10 – 11
- 2 Corinthians 5:10
- Rev. 20:12 says those dead will be judged according to their deeds

### THE BOOKS OF JUDGMENT





"Any tree that does not produce good fruit is cut down and thrown in the fire!"

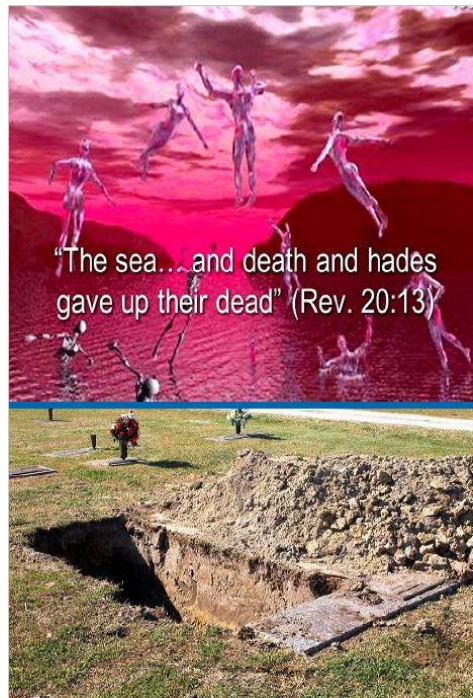
- Works and deeds DO matter to God!
- All Believers are expected to produce good works (good fruit)
- Matthew 7:17 – 20
- The Book of Deeds records the works we have done, both good and bad
- The Book of Life records saved Believers
- The standard that will be used: Matt. 5:17 - 19

- Bible is clear there ARE different levels of eternal society in Heaven based on deeds
- Vs. 12 says all who are raised from the dead will be judged on their deeds
- No matter; those not written in the Book of Life are sent to Hell regardless of how good their deeds might have been in life

"The sea... and death and hades gave up their dead" (Rev. 20:13)

- **She'ol**, not Hell or Hades
- Hades is the Greek mythical underworld
- **She'ol** means the grave
- Hebrew burial requires soil
- No such thing as "burial at sea" for Hebrews
- Death = **thanatos** = the miserable state of the dead
