There are two ways to view problems:

- As obstacles.
- As <u>opportunities</u>.

How can Christian leaders deal with problems?

1. Expect them! (1)

"In those days when the number of disciples was increasing."

• With success comes change and <u>problems</u>—always.

2. <u>Respect</u> them. (1)

"The Grecian Jews among them complained."

• Wise leaders don't mistake their troops for <u>the enemy</u>.

3. <u>Prioritize</u> them. (2)

"It would not be right for us to neglect..."

• Wise leaders know they can't <u>do everything</u>.

4. <u>Delegate</u> them. (3)

"We will turn this responsibility over to them."

• In order to do our main jobs well, we must <u>delegate well</u>.

5. Focus on the <u>main job</u>. (2, 4)

"We will give our attention to prayer... and the Word."

• Wise leaders know their main jobs are prayer & the Word.
