What does it mean to be filled with the Spirit

Understanding the Filling of the Holy Spirit

Ephesians 5:18-20 / ESV, "And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the Spirit, **19** addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, **20** giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, **21** submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ."

1. Focus on being fillable

Ephesians 5:18a / ESV, "Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery..."

- Wrong Equations for Filling
- · The Right Equation for Filling

2. Following a command given by God.

Ephesians 5:18b / ESV, "Instead, be filled with the Spirit"

God's Command to "Be Filled"

(Ephesians 5:18 contains this imperative from the Apostle Paul: "Be filled with the Spirit.)

3. Faithfully execute my responsibilities

Ephesians 5:19-20 / ESV, "addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart, **20** giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, **21** submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ."

Our Definition:

To live a life that is fully surrendered and dependent upon the gracious Spirit of God.

Closing statement:

It's not about getting more of the Spirit but giving more of ourselves to the Spirit.
