Luke 17:11-14 / ESV, "On the way to Jerusalem he was passing along between Samaria and Galilee. 12 And as he entered a village, he was met by ten lepers, who stood at a distance 13 and lifted up their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." 14 When he saw them he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went they were cleansed."

epistátēs: authority, overseer

Lamentations 3:22-23 / NLT, "The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. **23** Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning."

Luke 17:15-16 / ESV, Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice; 16 and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan."

First Samuel 1:27-28 / NLT, "I asked the Lord to give me this boy, and he has granted my request. 28 Now I am giving him to the Lord, and he will belong to the Lord his whole life." And they worshiped the Lord there."

Daniel 6:10 / ESV, "When Daniel knew that the document had been signed, he went to his house where he had windows in his upper chamber open toward Jerusalem. He got down on his knees three times a day and prayed and gave thanks before his God, as he had done previously."
