Week 5: Quenching the Spirit. of The Holy Spirit

- With Ray Parascando

First Thessalonians 5:12-28 / NIV, "Now we ask you, brothers and sisters, to acknowledge those who work hard among you, who care for you in the Lord and who admonish you. 13 Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work. Live in peace with each other. 14 And we urge you, brothers and sisters, warn those who are idle and disruptive, encourage the disheartened, help the weak, be patient with everyone. 15 Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always strive to do what is good for each other and for everyone else. 16 Rejoice always, 17 pray continually, 18 give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 19 Do not guench the Spirit. 20 Do not treat prophecies with contempt 21 but test them all; hold on to what is good, 22 reject every kind of evil. 23 May God himself, the God of peace, sanctify you through and through. May your whole spirit, soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 The one who calls you is faithful, and he will do it. 25 Brothers and sisters, pray for us. 26 Greet all God's people with a holy kiss. 27 I charge you before the Lord to have this letter read to all the brothers and sisters. 28 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you."

Examples of Quenching the Holy Spirit (First Thessalonians 5:12-28):

- 1. We guench the Spirit when we become divisive
- 2. We quench the Spirit when we neglect prayer
- 3. We quench the Spirit when we entertain evil
- 4. We quench the Spirit when we neglect prophetic utterances that are in accordance with the Scripture

- 5. We quench the Spirit when we are <u>living</u> in sin
- **6.** We quench the Spirit when we are <u>lazy church members</u>
- 7. We quench the Spirit when we become agenda and ego driven

Ephesians 5:19 / ESV, "addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart"

Colossians 3:16 / ESV, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God."
