Principles:

.....
1. Focus on being a follower instead of a fan v:23

Luke 9:23 / ESV,
“If anyone wants to follow after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross daily, and follow me.”

.....
2. Refuse to stay stuck in fear v:24-6a

Psalm 27:1 / CSB,
“The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?”

3. Think of faith as taking a healthy risk v:26b-27

Matthew 9:29 / CSB,
“Then he touched their eyes, saying, “Let it be done for you according to your faith.” to your faith be it done to you.”
