Session 4: Blessed Are The Meek

Matthew 5:5 / NIV; "Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth."

Lesson outline:



The misconception of being meek:

Meekness means Weakness

Benefits of meekness:

Satisfaction (Psalm 22:26) Guidance (Psalm 25:9) Wisdom (Proverbs 11:2) Fresh Joy (Isaiah 29:19) Protection (Zephaniah 2:3)

Meekness Principal: Healthy are the meek, for they shall enjoy the benefits of self-control.

1. Set God-approved boundaries for everything.

"Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses because of the Cushite woman whom he had married, for he had married a Cushite woman. 2 And they said, 'Has the Lord indeed spoken only through Moses? Has he not spoken through us also?' And the Lord heard it." — Numbers 12:1-2 / NIV

1 Peter 2:17 / NLT, "Respect everyone, and love the family of believers. Fear God, and respect the king."

Relational Boundaries = Respect others Spiritual Boundaries = Revere God

2. Focus on acting right over being right

"(Now the man Moses was very meek, more than all people who were on the face of the earth.) 4 And suddenly the Lord said to Moses and to Aaron and Miriam, 'Come out, you three, to the tent of meeting.' And the three of them came out. 5 And the Lord came down in a pillar of cloud and stood at the entrance of the tent and called Aaron and Miriam, and they both came forward," — Numbers 12:3-5 / NIV

3. God favors faithfulness over flamboyance

"And he said, 'Hear my words: If there is a prophet among you, I the Lord make myself known to him in a vision; I speak with him in a dream. 7 Not so with my servant Moses. He is faithful in all my house. 8 With him I speak mouth to mouth, clearly, and not in riddles, and he beholds the form of the Lord. Why then were you not afraid to speak against my servant Moses?' " — Numbers 12:6-8

4. Trust God's control over my circumstances

"And the anger of the Lord was kindled against them, and he departed. 10 When the cloud removed from over the tent, behold, Miriam was leprous...13 And Moses cried to the Lord, "O God, please heal her—please." — Numbers 12:9-10a; 13 / NIV
