How we know we are His.

We know we are His, if we keep His commandments.

"2 He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world. 3 And <u>by this we know</u> that we have come to know him, if we keep his commandments. 4 Whoever says "I know him" but does not keep his commandments is a liar, and the truth is not in him, 5 but whoever keeps his word, in him truly the love of God is perfected. <u>By this we may know that we are in him</u>: 6 whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked." (1 John 2:2–6 <u>ESV</u>)

What about those who left and didn't come back? They were not of us.

"18 Children, it is the last hour, and as you have heard that antichrist is coming, so now many antichrists have come. Therefore we know that it is the last hour. 19 They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us. But they went out, that it might become plain that they all are not of us. 20 But you have been anointed by the Holy One, and you all have knowledge. 21 I write to you, not because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and because no lie is of the truth. 22 Who is the liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, he who denies the Father and the Son. 23 No one who denies the Son has the Father. Whoever confesses the Son has the Father also." (1 John 2:18–23 ESV)

We know we have life...we love the brothers.

"14 <u>We know</u> that we have passed out of death into life, <u>because we love</u> <u>the brothers.</u> Whoever does not love abides in death. ¹⁵ Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him." (1 John 3:14–15 <u>ESV</u>)

We know we are of the truth...love in deed and truth.

"18 Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth. 19

By this we shall know that we are of the truth and reassure our heart before him; 20 for whenever our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and he knows everything. 21" (1 John 3:18–21 ESV)

We know because His love is perfected in us.

"12 No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us. 13 By this we know that we abide in him and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit." (1 John 4:12–13 ESV)

We know when...we love God and obey.

"1 Everyone who believes that Jesus is the Christ has been born of God, and everyone who loves the Father loves whoever has been born of him. 2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and obey his commandments. 3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome. 4 For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. 5 Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?" (1 John 5:1–5 ESV)
