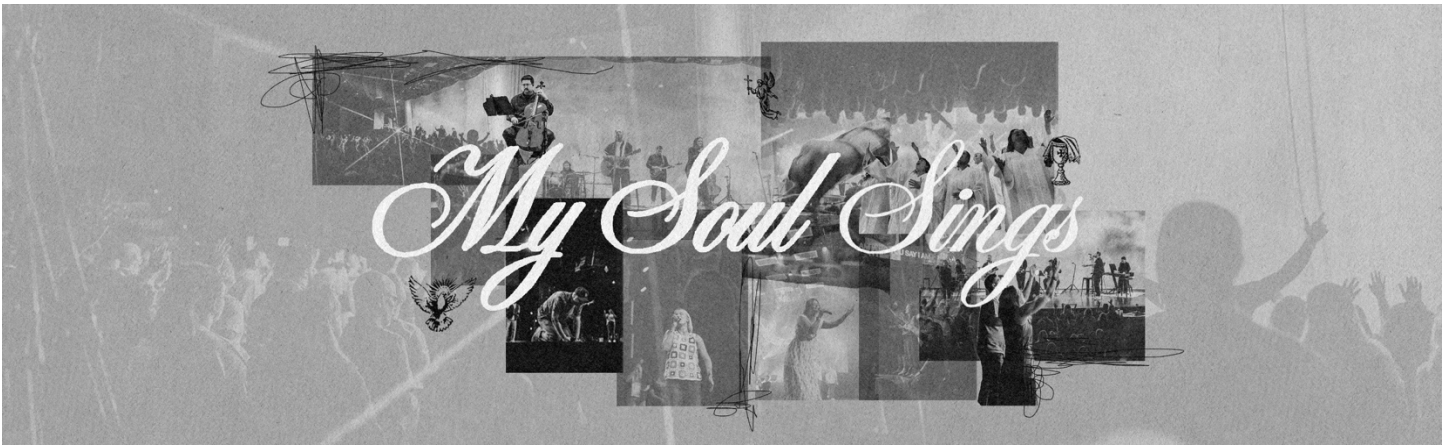




Where did it fall?

My Soul Sings // Week 3

Overview

Worship is not about us, it is about God. Every time we worship, we have the opportunity to bless Him, thank Him, and show Him what He is worth to us. While worship is ultimately for God, something powerful happens in us when we choose to be with Him. This week reminds us not to settle for simply attending church, but to have a genuine encounter with God that refreshes and renews our relationship with Him.

Opening Conversation

What has God done this week that you're praising Him for?

Read 2 Kings 6:5-7

- Why do you think Elisha first asked, "Where did it fall?" before performing the miracle?
- When we feel like we've lost the momentum with God, we often start looking for something new. Why do you think we tend to do that instead of looking back to where our passion began to fade?
- Can you identify a season where your relationship with God began to drift? What changed?

Read Revelation 2:4-5

- Think back to when you first gave your life to Christ. What was your passion, excitement, and desire to know Him like at that time? How has that changed?
- Jesus tells the church to "do the things you did at first." What might that look like in your own relationship with God today?

Read Psalm 100:1-5

- What words or phrases describe the attitude God desires when we come into His presence?
- What stands out to you in the passage, and how can it change the way you worship God moving forward?
- Scripture helps us **understand** God. Worship helps us **experience** God. How have you seen both of those play different but important roles in your relationship with Him?

Application

Pastor Tim challenged us to remember that **a vibrant faith comes from a lifestyle of worship not just a Sunday morning**. Worship creates space for us to experience God's presence and reconnect our hearts with Him.

This week, intentionally create time each day to worship. Whether it's listening to worship music in the car, spending a few minutes praising God before reading Scripture, or simply thanking Him throughout your day, ask God to renew your heart.

Closing Prayer

Heavenly Father, I praise you for who you are and all you've done. Lord, you are God – you made me, and I belong to you. I lift my praise and thanksgiving to You alone. Lord may the longing of my heart be that I am in your presence and honoring you for all that you are. Let my worship be how I reconnect with you, and may I always make the time to be in your presence.
