Hear who the Lord of glory is:

- Gen. 1:1 In the beginning, God
- Gen. 21:33 Abraham ... called there on the name of the LORD, the Everlasting God.
- Ex. 3:14 God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM."
- **Deut. 33:27** The eternal God is your dwelling place, and underneath are the everlasting arms.
- 1Chr. 16:36 Blessed be the LORD, the God of Israel, from everlasting to everlasting!
- **Psa. 90:2** Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God.
- **Psa. 50:12** "If I were hungry, I would not tell you, for the world and its fullness are mine.
- **Psa. 139:7-12** Where shall I go from your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from your presence? If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there! If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me. If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night," even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you.
