<u>UNLIKELY HEROES</u> <u>Ordinary Life, Extraordinary Purpose</u> June 24, 2018 "Use your ordinary life to live out your extraordinary purpose"

Daily walking w/ Jesus is vital to fulfilling God's *purpose* for our lives.

God knows you. He made you. God has a <u>plan & a purpose</u> for your life. This is a series about daily <u>pursuing your purpose</u>.

"As long as you still have a **pulse**, God still has a **purpose** for your life."

Jeremiah 1:5 "I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born I set you apart..." (*AMP...I had holy plans for you*)

God has a reason for you being alive, in this place, at this time, now !!

<u>"You are important & your part in His plan is important!"</u> John 6:5 MSG Jesus looked out & saw that a large crowd had arrived, He said to Philip, "Where can we buy bread to feed these people?" He said this to stretch Philip's faith. He already knew what He was going to do. 7 Philip answered, "200 silver pieces wouldn't be enough to buy bread for each person to get a piece." 8 One of the disciples— Andrew, brother Peter—said, "There's a little boy here who has five barley loaves & two fish. But that's a drop in the bucket for a crowd like this." 10 Jesus said, "Make the people sit down." There was a nice carpet of green grass... They sat down, about 5000 of them. Jesus took the bread & having given thanks, gave it to those who were seated. He did the same w/ the fish. All ate as much as they wanted. 12 When the people had eaten their fill, He said to His disciples, "Gather the leftovers so nothing's wasted." They went to work & filled twelve large baskets w/ leftovers from the five barley loaves.

Do you know: Your personal purpose? Where you're going? What you want to do w/ your life?

Let's study, pray & seek Jesus to lead us to His **purpose** for our lives.

John 15:16 AMP You haven't chosen Me, but I've <u>chosen</u> you & I've <u>appointed</u> you; I've <u>planted</u> you that you might go bear fruit & keep on bearing; that your fruit may be lasting; remain & abide; that whatever you ask the Father in My Name, He may give it to you.

You must have & <u>walk in</u> God's vision & purpose for your life. True success is <u>daily</u> knowing & fulfilling God's will for your life.

To **know** God's will & purpose is the greatest **treasure** you can have. <u>AND</u>

To fulfill God's will & purpose is the greatest pleasure you can have.

It's up to each of us to spend time w/ God & make sure that we have the Lord's will & purposes for our lives.

As you walk in God's purposes & plans, Jesus moves you forward in His upward call for your life.

Ephesians 5:15 AMP Look carefully then how you <u>walk</u>! Live <u>**purposefully**</u> & worthily, accurately, not as the unwise & witless, but as wise (sensible, intelligent people), 16 Making the very most of the time [buying up each opportunity]...

As you walk in God's purpose, don't let your passion diminish!

Jeremiah 20:9 If I say I'll never mention the Lord or speak in His name, <u>His Word burns in my heart like a fire.</u> It's like a <u>fire in my bones</u>! I am worn out trying to hold it in! I can't do it! With that kind of passion for Jesus and the Word of God, you'll receive direction & purpose for your life.

God didn't make a mistake when you were born! He knows that you're alive & living here right now. He has a plan & a purpose for your life.

Living out your extraordinary purpose is greater than happiness, your family, career, or all of your dreams & ambitions!

It's not about you. You were born **by** <u>His</u> purpose & **for** <u>His</u> purpose!

Colossians 1:15 MSG We *look at this Son* & *see the God* who cannot be seen. We *look at this Son* & see God's original *purpose* in everything created. For everything, absolutely everything, above & below, visible & invisible, rank after rank after rank of angels—*everything got started in Him* & *finds its purpose in Him.*

Focusing on ourselves will never reveal your life's purpose. You can't do or be or fulfill your life's purpose while focused on yourself.

Don't ask questions like: What do<u>I</u> want to be? What should<u>I</u> do w/ <u>my</u> life? What are <u>my</u> goals; <u>my</u> ambitions; <u>my</u> dreams; <u>my</u> future?

You were made for God, not the other way around. Life is about letting God use you for His purposes, not using Him for your own purpose.

This isn't a self-help sermon. This isn't about reaching your goals, fulfilling your dreams, your career, or planning & living a successful life.

Living a successful life & doing/fulfilling your God-given purposes are two different issues entirely.

You can be very successful according to the world's standards & miss the purposes that God has for your life.

Acts 1:20 Peter said, "This was written in the book of Psalms, where it says, 'Let his home become desolate, w/ no one living in it.' It also says, 'Let someone else take his position.' 21 "So now we must choose a replacement for Judas from among the men who were w/ us the entire time we were traveling w/ the Lord Jesus; 22 from the time he was baptized by John until the day he was taken from us. Whoever's chosen will join us as a witness of Jesus' resurrection." 23 So they nominated two men: *Joseph* called Barsabbas & *Matthias*. 24 Then they all prayed, "O Lord, You know every heart. Show us which of these men <u>You've</u> <u>chosen</u> as an apostle to replace Judas in this ministry, for he's deserted us & gone where he belongs."26 They cast lots & Matthias was selected to become an apostle w/ the other eleven.

Not Just Speculation, But Revelation!

God's not just the starting point of your life, He's the source of your life.

Ephesians 1:11 MSG *It's* <u>*in Christ*</u> *that we find out who we are* & <u>*what*</u> <u>*we're living for*</u>. Long before we first heard of Christ & got our hopes up, He had His eye on us, had designs on us for glorious living, part of the overall <u>*purpose*</u> He's working out in everything & everyone.

From this passage, we see 3 things:

- 1. You discover & experience your identity & purpose through a relationship w/ Jesus Christ.
- 2. God was thinking of you long before you were ever thinking about Him. You may choose your career, spouse, hobbies, & other parts of your life, but you don't get to choose your purpose.
- 3. The purpose of your life fits into a much larger purpose that God has designed for eternity.

You may feel in the dark about your purpose in life, but you're about to walk into the light...daily.
