Ephesians 2:10 AMP We're *His workmanship*. *His own master work*; a work of art, created *in Christ Jesus*; reborn from above; spiritually transformed, renewed, ready to be used for good works...

TPT We have become His poetry, a re-created people that will fulfill the destiny He's given each of us, for we're joined to Jesus, the Anointed One...

God has a plan & a purpose for your life.

Dare to be everything that God created you to be.

Make who God says you are bigger than the lies of the enemy.

Genesis 1:26 God said, "Let us make human beings in our image, to be like us. They'll reign over the fish in the sea, birds in the sky, livestock, all the wild animals on the earth, & small animals that scurry along the ground." 27 God created human beings in His own image. In the image of God He created them; male & female He created them. 28 Then God blessed them & said, "Be fruitful & multiply. Fill the earth & govern it. 29 Then God said, "Look! I've given you every seed-bearing plant throughout the earth & all the fruit trees for your food. 30 I've given every green plant as food for all the wild animals, birds in the sky, & small animals that scurry along the ground-everything that has life." That is what happened. 31 Then God looked over all He had made, & He saw that it was very good!

Genesis 2 man & woman living large in the garden; naked – unashamed

Genesis 3:1 The serpent was the shrewdest of all the wild animals the Lord God had made. One day he asked the woman, "Did God really say you must not eat the fruit from any of the trees in the garden?" 2 "Of course we may eat fruit from the trees in the garden," the woman replied. 3 "It's only the fruit from the tree in the middle of the garden that we're not allowed to eat. God said, 'You must not eat it or even touch it; if you do, you will die." 4 "You won't die!" the serpent replied to the woman. 5 'God knows that your eyes will be opened as soon as you eat it & you'll be like God, knowing both good & evil." 6 The woman was convinced. She saw that the tree was beautiful & its fruit looked delicious & she wanted the wisdom it would give her. She took some of the fruit & ate it. Then she gave some to her husband, who was w/ her, & he ate it, too. 7 At that moment their eyes were opened, & they suddenly felt shame at their nakedness. So they sewed fig leaves together to cover themselves. 8 When the cool evening breezes were blowing, the man & his wife heard the Lord God walking about in the garden. So they hid from the Lord God among the trees. 9 Then the Lord God called to the man, "Where are you?" 10 He replied, "I heard You walking in the garden, so I hid. I was afraid because I was naked." 11 "Who told you that you were naked?" the Lord God asked. "Have you eaten from the tree whose fruit I commanded you not to eat?"

12 The man replied, "It was the woman You gave me who gave me the fruit, & I ate it." 13 Then the Lord God asked the woman, "What have you done?" "The serpent deceived me," she replied. "That's why I ate it."

Don't let your mistakes or failures or worst moments identify you. You can move past your past. In Jesus, you are so much more.

He cleansed your sin, redeemed your shame, & set you free – forever. Walk in that Jesus freedom today!

Colossians 2:8 TPT Beware that no one distracts you or intimidates you *in their attempt to lead you away from <u>Christ's fullness</u> by pretending to be full of wisdom when they're filled w/ endless arguments of human logic. For they operate w/ humanistic & clouded judgments based on the mindset of this world system, & not the anointed truths of the Anointed One. 9 He's the <u>complete fullness</u> of deity living in human form 10 Our own completeness is now found <u>in Him</u>. We're completely <u>filled w/ God</u> as <u>Christ's fullness</u> overflows <u>w/in</u> us.*

Only allow God to accurately identify you. We identify ourselves w/ Christ, by knowing Jesus

Philippians 3:8 Everything else is worthless when compared w/ the infinite value of knowing Jesus. For His sake, I've discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage so that I could gain Christ ⁹ & become <u>one</u> <u>w/ Him</u>. I no longer count on my own righteousness through obeying the law; rather, I become *righteous through faith in Christ*. For God's way of making us *right w/ Himself* depends on faith.
