GET UP Strengthen Yourself in the Lord January 7, 2024

John 16:33 AMP I've told you these things, so that in Me you may have perfect peace. In the world you have <u>tribulation & distress & suffering</u>, but be courageous; be confident, be undaunted, be filled w/ joy; I have overcome the world." My conquest is accomplished, My victory abiding.

We all have personal issues & outward influences that bring us down. (stress, sickness, weak, broken, sin, politics, money, family, work, etc.)

Most of us, most of the time rely on our "flesh" to get up.

1 Samuel 30:3 When David & his men came to the city, they found it burned w/ fire, & their wives & sons & daughters taken captive. 4 Then David & the people who were w/ him raised their voices & <u>wept</u> until they had <u>no more strength</u> to weep. 5 David's two wives also had been taken captive, Ahinoam of Jezreel & Abigail the widow of Nabal of Carmel. 6 David was greatly distressed, for the people spoke of stoning him, because all the people were <u>bitter in soul</u>, each for his sons & daughters. But David <u>strengthened himself in the LORD</u> his God.

1 Chronicles 16:11 AMP Seek the Lord & *His strength*; Seek His face continually [longing to be in His presence].

Nehemiah 8:10b ...Don't be dejected & sad, for *the joy of the Lord is your strength!*

Psalm 18:1 I love you, Lord; <u>*You are my strength*</u>. 2 The Lord is my rock, my fortress, & my savior; my God is my rock, in whom I find protection. He is my shield, the power that saves me, & my place of safety. 3 I called on the Lord, who is worthy of praise, & He saved me from my enemies.

Psalm 28:6 Praise the Lord! For He has heard my cry for mercy. 7 The Lord is <u>my strength</u> & shield. I trust Him w/ all my heart. He helps me, & my heart is filled w/ joy. I burst out in songs of thanksgiving. 8 <u>The Lord</u> <u>gives His people strength</u>. He is a safe fortress...

Psalm 46:1 God is our refuge & *strength*, always ready to help in times of trouble. 2 So we will not fear when earthquakes come & the mountains crumble into the sea. 3 Let the oceans roar & foam. Let the mountains tremble as the waters surge!

Psalm 59:9 <u>You are my strength</u>; I <u>wait</u> for you to rescue me, for you, O God, are my fortress.... **16** As for me, I will sing about Your power. Each morning I will sing w joy about your unfailing love. For You've been my refuge, a place of safety when I'm in distress. 17 O my <u>Strength</u>, to You I sing praises, for You, O God, are my refuge, the God who shows me unfailing love.

Psalm 73:26 My health may fail, & my spirit may grow weak, but God remains the *strength of my heart*; He is mine forever.

Isaiah 40:28b The Lord is the everlasting God, the Creator of all the earth He never grows weak or weary. No one can measure the depths of His understanding. 29 He gives *power to the weak & strength to the powerless*. 30 Even youths will become weak & tired, young men will fall in exhaustion 31 But those who trust in the Lord will find *new strength*. They'll soar high on wings like eagles. They'll run & not grow weary. They'll walk & not faint

*Personal Expectations

1 Corinthians 16:13 AMP Be on guard; stand firm in your faith in God, respecting His precepts & keeping your doctrine sound. Act like mature men & *be courageous; be strong*.

Ephesians 6:10 ...Be <u>strong in the Lord</u> & in <u>His mighty power</u>. 11 Put on all of God's armor so that you'll be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil.

Wisdom from Solomon - he had issues (not least of all, over 700 wives)

Proverbs 24:16 The Godly may trip *(fall)* seven times, but they'll *get up* again. But one disaster is enough to overthrow the wicked.

TPT For the lovers of God may suffer adversity & stumble seven times, but they will continue to rise over & over again. But the unrighteous are brought down by just one calamity & *will never be able to rise again*.

Godly & wicked – Which people fall? Who falls more? You can't fall if you're not standing up. I can't fall when I'm down.

Why do the Godly keep falling down? Because they keep getting up!

The KEY to strengthening yourself in the Lord - Keep getting up!!

When we fall, when we're down we have a choice. If/when we choose to get up, guess what's a possibility now?

You're down again (sin), you cry out to Jesus, repent, get up & walk. This time you fall, repent, get up & walk farther...etc.

Keep getting up!!

Ephesians 3:16 AMP May He grant you out of the riches of His glory, to be *strengthened* & spiritually energized w/ power through His Spirit in your inner self, indwelling your innermost being & personality...
