### **Key Scriptures:**

### 1 Corinthians 15:57

"But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."

### **Praising and Thanking God**

Having hearts of praise and thanksgiving makes all the difference in our lives. It is not always easy to have a thankful heart. Life's challenges can weigh heavily upon us, and our souls can be weighed down with many cares. When we make the choice to offer to God a sacrifice of praise we are empowered into places of victory. It is up to each of us to make the choice to magnify the Lord.

## **Magnifying the Lord**

### 1. Magnifying God leads to victory.

- a. To magnify God means to see Him greater than all else.
- b. We thank God because He gives us victory through Jesus (1 Corinthians 15:57).
  - i. We can tell our souls to remember God's goodness, and to bless Him (Psalm 103:1-3).
- c. Keys to present and future victories are praise and thanksgiving.
  - i. These magnify the Lord over life's problems.
- d. Sometimes it is a sacrifice to praise God through the hard times. The Bible calls this a sacrifice of praise (Hebrews 13:15).
- e. God always gives us the victory through Jesus, so we praise (2 Corinthians 2:14).

#### 2. The enemy distracts us from magnifying God.

- a. Our thought life can be polluted by the enemy's thoughts.
  - i. He tries to fill us with stinking thinking.
- b. The enemy tries to fill our minds with thoughts that magnify the problems and frustrations of life. He wants to fill us with doubt, anger, and anxiety.
- c. Don't listen to the enemy when he says no one else has been through what you're going through.

#### 3. We are to always magnify the Lord.

- a. In everything we are to give thanks (1 Thessalonians 5:18).
  - i. We do not thank God for everything, but despite everything.
- b. Thanksgiving puts us in a position for God to show Himself strong in our lives.
- c. Jesus thanked God for the small lunch and then fed 5,000 (John 6:3-13).
  - i. We should give thanks, and value what God has given us.
  - ii. Honor what God has given us in talents and giftings.
  - iii. What we are not thankful for we are in danger of losing.
- d. Overflowing life comes from overflowing gratitude (John 10:10).
