Who is this gift?

Jesus Christ, the wonderful counselor, He is the Living Word and our only true source of wisdom, guidance, and truth

Mighty God:

He is our infinite Hero and Divine Warrior who has triumphed over sin and death and given us the victory!

Everlasting Father:

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

He is the one who was and is and forever will be everywhere present and will always; rule with power, authority on the throne of Heaven

Everlasting means He will never cease to exist as our Father to care for us!

Prince of Peace:

He is the One who offers real peace because that's who He peace. He is the only real source of peace and He offers it to us as a child of God

This Gift's Great Power:

Romans 8:31,32 What then shall we say to these things? If God *is* for us, who *can be* against us? ³² He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

This gift breaks the power of sin and gives us eternal life. He did not spare His own Son

That's what makes this gift both powerful and valuable. He saves us from our old life and gives us a brand new life filled with hope, peace, salvation, and complete freedom!

1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

What should be our response to this perfect gift?

Accept His gift with a thankful heart by faith

Unwrapping this gift will call for a life of repentance and a changed life full of His blessings and favor!

Rom 10:9-10 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Then you follow the example of the perfect gift by sharing Jesus with the lost, blind, and hopeless and broken because He has now given us the capacity to love others – even our enemies

Now that you've found life, share it!

This gift was not free to God, it cost His only Son's life as our sacrifice

He paid for this gift of eternal life with the precious blood of His Son!
