**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:** What is the fair payment for sin? The fair payment for sin is death.

**CHRIST CONNECTION:** After God's people sinned, the judges helped God's people obey God again. But the judges could not change the people's hearts and make them love God. God had a plan. He sent His Son, Jesus, to change His people's hearts and save them from sin forever.

**DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP:** As a family, read the Bible verse for the unit. Discuss what it means to you and share with your kids how you came to ask Jesus in your heart. Talk about salvation openly and answer any questions the kids might have. As we journey through lent in expectation of Easter present the Gospel in different ways to your kids. God's word won't return void!

**Q.** If we are sorry for our sins, will our sins still have consequences? Why? *(Even when we repent of our sins, we may still face the consequences of that sin. For example, a parent might take away a privilege as a consequence of disobeying. Christians have to remember that after receiving salvation, sin no longer has power over us. Jesus broke the power of sin. Through Jesus, we can have victory over sin in our lives. When you are tempted to sin, you can pray and ask God to help you say no to sin. Gal. 6:7.)*

**Q.** Why is it important to remember what God has done? *(throughout the Bible, we are told to remember the works of the Lord. Through His deeds, we can understand God's character and recognize that nothing else compares to Him. He alone is worthy of our worship and our obedience. John 14:26)*
