**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:** What is worship? Worship is celebrating the greatness of God.

**CHRIST CONNECTION:** God deserves our worship. He created us to be in a relationship with Him, and He has provided salvation from sin through His Son, Jesus. We can worship God by loving and obeying Him as we live to give Him glory.

**DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP:** As you gather with family and friends to celebrate Thanksgiving; encourage your children to express their gratitude for things that we often take for granted. Guide them to understand that one of the best ways to show our thanks is to love and trust Him and to follow Him closely by obeying what He says.

**Q.** How are the offerings you can give similar to the offerings the Israelites gave? How are they different? *(Christians can still give resources—money, food, clothing, time, talents, and so forth—as a way to serve the church and glorify God. But we no longer give sin offerings because Jesus died on the cross becoming the ultimate sacrifice to grant forgiveness of sins)*
