**Numbers 21**

**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:** What is God like? There is no one like God. He is perfect, good, and loving.

**CHRIST CONNECTION:** God sent snakes to punish the people, but anyone who was bitten could look at the snake on the pole and live. We deserve to die because of our sin, but anyone who looks to Jesus on the cross and trusts in Him will live forever with God.

**DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP:** During dinner or family time, review the gospel and encourage kids to speak with you their Sunday school teacher if they have any questions. Then pray, thanking God for His love and provision of a savior, Jesus.

— *Ask* —

- Q.** Why do you think the Israelites doubted God? (*Discuss the consequences for Israel's sin. Emphasize how consequences are the result of our sin and how the consequences helped change the attitude of the Israelites. Num. 21:5-6*)
- Q.** How does looking to Jesus help us trust Him?(discuss that the punishment Jesus took on the cross wasn't for His sin, but ours. Knowing Jesus took the blame for our sin, it should lead us to take our sin very seriously. By remembering Jesus, we have hope because of His sacrifice for us. *2 Cor. 5:21*)
- Q.**How can we live in a way that reflects our trust in God? (Our obedience reflects our trust in Jesus. He is the perfect example of this. *John 14:15*)
