Joshua 23-24

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: A miracle is something God does that usually cannot be done so that we can know He is all-powerful.

CHRIST CONNECTION: As Joshua prepared for his own death, he left behind a legacy of obedience to God. After Jesus' death and resurrection, He appeared to the disciples and left them with a legacy: to obey Him by making disciples of all nations.

DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP: As a family, make a list of all the gifts God has given you in the past year. Try to remember as many as possible. As you read over all the items on the list discuss how your love and gratitude for God grows. A natural response is to worship Him for what He has done and who HE IS. Spend the rest of the time worshipping God through prayer or song- play a family favorite worship song and sing it together.

— Ask —

Q. Why do you think Joshua wanted the Israelites to meditate on and obey God's Word? (*Joshua knew that God's word would help direct the people and show them how to live. The Bible helps us to follow God's plan for our lives. It helps us to know and follow Him. Isaiah 46:9*)

Q. How can we respond to the truth that God is all-powerful? (*Joshua reminded the people of the many miracles God had worked, and then he told them to choose whether or not to follow God. When we remember that God is all-powerful, we can respond by deciding to follow and live for Him. We can respect, honor, and worship Him, and we can have faith, courage, and confidence. Joshua 24:15*)
