Numbers 20

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: What is God like? There is no one like God. He is perfect, good, and loving.

CHRIST CONNECTION: Moses disobeyed God, so he could not go into the promised land. God sent Jesus, who always obeyed God. When we trust in Jesus, He brings us into God's kingdom forever.

DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP: Children love stories! Consider sharing a personal story about a time you disobeyed your parents, and your consequences. Share how you felt and how that might have made your parents feel. Discuss the love of our Heavenly Father regardless of our sin, but also the JOY He feels when we choose to obey Him.

— *Ask* —

Q. Why was God angry that Moses disobeyed? (*When we disobey God, it's because we choose to do things our way, instead of God's way. Disobedience comes from our lack of trust in God. Gen 3: 6-7*)

Q. What can we do to help us obey when obeying is hard? (*Remind kids that God's Word points to God's faithfulness, love, and goodness. Ps. 28:7*)

Q. What can we learn from Jesus about obeying? (*Jesus is the perfect example of obedience. Jesus obeyed the Father to the point of death on the cross for the sin of the world. Because of what Jesus faced on the cross, we should strive to obey with joy. Phil. 2:8*)
