Ephesians 2

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: What is the fair payment for sin? The fair payment for sin is death.

CHRIST CONNECTION: God takes sin seriously. People deserve to die for their sins, but God loves us and sent His Son, Jesus, to defeat death by dying on the cross for our sins and rising from the dead. Everyone who trusts in Jesus has eternal life.

DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP: This week the Gospel was presented in class. Follow up with your kids; ask them questions and provide answers. Take this opportunity to gauge where your kids are in terms of readiness to receive Jesus in their hearts. Pray for the Lord to give you insight and prompt you to invite them to accept the gift of Salvation. Be careful not to pressure them, but simply talk openly about the Gospel and how it is the Lord who will guide both their heart to accept, and yours to direct the conversation.

— *Ask* —

Q. Does God ever allow sin to go unpunished? (*God is just, which means He always does what is right. God takes sin seriously, so seriously that He sent His Son, Jesus, to take the punishment of sin for those who trust Him as their Savior. Sometimes it can look as though God has left some sin unpunished, but there is a day coming when God will punish all sin and make everything right, the way He intended. Rev. 21:4.*)

Q. Who can be saved? (*God offers the gift of salvation to everyone. The Bible says that God's love for the whole world is what caused Him to send His Son, Jesus, to be the Rescuer. There is no one too sinful or too far away from God to be saved. Rom. 5:8.*)
