

*Read***Joshua 7-11***Jesus Storybook Bible p. 29*

**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:** A miracle is something God does that usually cannot be done so that we can know He is all-powerful.

**CHRIST CONNECTION:** Joshua's name means "The Lord is salvation." God fought for Joshua and the Israelites, saving them and giving them victory over their enemies. Sinners can look to God for victory over sin and death. God brought us salvation by sending His Son, Jesus, to die on the cross and rise again.

**DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP:** Share with your family a time in your life where you had a difficult almost impossible problem and how God gave you the victory. After you have shared, invite your kids to think of times when God has answered their prayer and helped them. Take this opportunity to discuss how God keeps His promises in the old Bible times and even today!!

— Ask —

**Q.** Why do you think God answered Joshua's prayer to stop the sun and moon? (*God answered Joshua's prayer as part of His plan. Without God, Israel would have lost the battle. God told Joshua that He had handed over Israel's enemies; He spoke as if it had already happened even though it hadn't yet. God had already decided that Israel would have victory, and He would give it to them. Josh. 10:8,14*)

**Q.** When you remember that God is all-powerful, one response is to honor, respect, and worship Him. How else can you respond? How should you act when you face difficulty? (*When you remember all the miracles God has worked and think about all the amazing things He has done, it can help your faith to grow. This can help you to have courage and confidence, even in difficult situations. Deut. 31:6*)
