BIG PICTURE QUESTION: What is the Bible? The Bible is God's Word that tells us what is true about God and ourselves.

CHRIST CONNECTION: God went ahead of Joshua and the Israelites into the promised land. He showed His power to them so they would trust in Him. When Jesus came to earth, He showed His power so people would trust in Him and be saved from sin

DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP: Find ways to establish family "milestones"-times when you create a marker to remind you of specific moments in which God displayed His power and faithfulness to your family. Build rhythms in your life to slow down and recount God's faithfulness to each other as a family.

— *Ask* —

Q. What would the stones remind the people of Israel and their children about? *(It would remind them of God's power and His faithfulness; God always keeps His promises. Hebrews 10:23.)*

Q. Why is it important to remember God? *(It is important to be reminded of all the ways God has been good to us, and even throughout time. When we remember Him our faith and trust in Him grows. Psalm 100:4-5)*

Q. How can remembering thinking about God help you when you feel afraid? *(When we follow Jesus, we can trust that His Word will lead and guide us as we read it and do what it says. Ps. 119:105.)*
