MAIN STORY POINT:

Jesus allowed His enemies to arrest him

BIG PICTURE QUESTION:

What did Jesus do to save us? Jesus lived a sinless life, died on the cross, and rose from the dead.

CHRIST CONNECTION

Jesus obeyed His Father's Plan no matter what.

DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP:

At the dinner table or on your commute this week, talk about times when it has been difficult or scary to identify as a Christian who wants to obey God. Share a time when you identified with Christ when it wasn't popular or a time when you failed. Read John 21:15-25 to see how Jesus restores Peter, and reassure your kids of God's endless grace, even when we fail.

— *Ask* —

- Q. Why was Jesus sad while He prayed?
- Q. Why did Jesus not fight back when He was arrested?
- Q. How would you feel if one of your friends said she didn't even know you like Peter said about Jesus?
- Q. When might we feel tempted to pretend we don't know Jesus?
- Q. Jesus laid down His life for us. How can we lay down our lives for others?
