Numbers 13-14

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: What is God like? There is no one like God. He is perfect, good, and loving.

CHRIST CONNECTION: The Israelites did not obey God because they did not trust Him. Jesus always trusted God. When we trust in Jesus, God forgives our sin.

DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP: It can be challenging to talk to our kids about common emotions, such as fear. God made us emotional beings and we are meant to worship him with our emotions as well as our actions and thoughts. Raising Boys and Girls podcast recently released some episodes to help parents guide their children when talking about fear and other emotions. You can also read and pray over the Psalms together as a family.

— *Ask* —

- Q.** How does Joshua remind us of Jesus? (*Joshua was not perfect, but His faithfulness reminds us of Jesus, who is perfect. Jesus obeyed the Father and trusted His plan to save people from their sins. Deut. 28:1-2*)
- Q.** How might our beliefs about God affect how we react in hard times? (*Remind kids that when we are afraid or have doubt, we can always pray and ask God for help to follow and obey Him. Prov. 3:5-6*)
- Q.** What can we do to help us trust God more?
