MOMENTS THAT MATTER



Read 1 Samuel 11

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: Why does sin separate us from God? Because God is holy, sin has broken our relationship with God.

CHRIST CONNECTION: God chose Saul to be the king in Israel, With God's help. Saul brought the Israelites together to win the battle. God sent His Son, Jesus, to be our King forever. Jesus came to rescue people from sin and death.

DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP: This week, talk with your kids about ways God has provided for and helped you in very specific situations. Make it a weekly rhythm to acknowledge how God is answering your prayers. Teach kids to give God the glory rather than seek fleshly acclaims. Read Phil. 4:19 and try to memorize it as a family.



- Q. How does Jesus bring together people who trust in Him? (Encourage kids to think of things believers have in common, like their faith in Jesus and their goal of telling others about Him. Remind kids that even if believers like different things or have different strengths, they can agree on the most important thing of all: they need Jesus to save them from sin and to fix their relationship with God
- Q. How can you follow Jesus' example to bring people together? (Guide kids to consider ways that Jesus connected with people in the Gospels (Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John). Remind kids that living out the fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22-23) helps others recognize God's Spirit living inside of them.)
