Isaiah 9

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: Does God keep His promises? Yes, God always keeps His promises.

CHRIST CONNECTION: God keeps His promises. God sent His Son, Jesus, into the world as a baby. Jesus saves sinners.

DAILY LIFE DISCIPLESHIP: This week, as you gather together around the Christmas tree place your attention on the lights, and lead your kids to recognize that Jesus brought the light into the world. Read Isaiah 9 and help kids recall the names of Jesus: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace.

— *Ask* —

Q. What do Jesus' names tell us about Him? (*These names tell us who Jesus is and the great things He would do. Jesus would be a king who cares about His people. He would bring peace to the whole world. John 16:33*)

Q. Why should we tell others how God kept His promise by sending Jesus (*Guide kids to consider how the gospel frees us from the guilt of sin. Encourage kids to think of how the gospel affects those around us, as well. Rom. 6:23*)

Q. When can we tell others about God's faithfulness? (*Invite kids to think of major promises in the Bible that they can share with others and of all the times during the day they experience God's faithfulness. Ps. 63:4-5*)
