May and June 2025



It is a joy to honor his legacy and support young people in his memory. We honored our own graduates, Joel Foreman and Amber Wroten, at LifeSpring on **Graduation Sunday**.

As part of our Fostering Community outreach ministry, a team from the church completed a **landscape project for a local foster/adoption family**. We started this project last year as a way to bless this family and ease their load. Thank you to the hard-working team that sacrificed a Saturday to see it to completion.





Financial Snapshot: For the first time, we're including a financial snapshot in our newsletter to keep you informed and encouraged by the impact of your generosity.

As of June 30, general giving for 2025 is nearly on track with our budget, just \$5,000 under what was projected for the first half of the year. Our expenses have been lower than anticipated, which means we are currently \$4,500 in the positive. Praise God! But the story doesn't stop there.

In addition to general giving, over \$10,000 has been generously given toward scholarships, helping families in need, and sending students to Camp Cowen.

We've also been able to use over \$9,000 from last year's surplus to:

- Support specific families facing hardship,
- Contribute to our local ministerial association, which helps cover rent, groceries, and utility bills for local families in crisis, and
- Make important updates and repairs to the church van that was gifted to us last year.

We're grateful for how God is providing through you, and we'll continue to steward these gifts with care, prayer, and transparency.
