The Chili, Soup, Stew Cook-off brought in around \$600.00. Wonderful time.



# Food Pantry Ministry February Report

Thank you for your continued support to our Food Pantry Ministry.

During February we added a new program to our Food Pantry Ministry. We packed easy to access foods for homeless clients who come by.

In February, we had financial support from our congregation as well as Grass Lick Baptist, Flatwoods United Methodist, and Centennial Church. Also, to Ripley Library, Walmart, Kroger, our Tai Chi Class, and Evans Eagles 4-H Club for their food donations during February.

During February we brought in 5,035 lbs. of food, 2,778 lbs. were donated and 2,537 lbs. were purchased.

Food donations included 1,371 lbs. from USDA, 572 lbs. from Walmart, and ~ 400 lbs. of apples from Red Barn.

We purchased \$2,537 of food, \$538 of food from Kroger, \$137 from Walmart and \$1,862 of from Mountaineer Food Bank.

We served 136 households or 435 individuals.
