The current anticipated schedule is that they will remove the windows with the sash sometime in late March 2026. They anticipate this project to take 4-6 months to complete. There are 56 windows. We will still accept any donations you want to make for the remaining windows.

- · Enter your name and click 'Continue.'
- · Click 'Add Recipes' to begin adding your recipes.

Recipe Writing Tips:

- · When adding recipes, review the "Tips" and use standard abbreviations.
- · Only enter 1 ingredient per ingredient line.
- · List ingredients in order of use in the ingredients list and directions.
- · Include container sizes, e.g., (16-oz.) pkg., (24-oz.) can.
- · Write directions in paragraph form, not in steps.
- · Use names of ingredients in the directions, e.g., "Combine flour and sugar." DO NOT use statements like, "Combine first three ingredients."
- · Include temperatures and cooking, chilling, baking, and/or freezing times.
- · Additional comments about the recipe (history, nutritional data, suggested uses, etc.) are not allowed unless a "Recipe Note" field is visible. Enter extra recipe content in that field.
