

# Community Group Discussion Guide

Be Where You're Supposed to Be

---

## Opening (5–10 min)

Icebreaker:

- What's a small or "ordinary" moment in your week that ended up being more meaningful than you expected?
  - OR: Have you ever felt like your life lacked purpose in a season? What did that feel like?
- 

## Big Idea

**Because of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, every moment of our lives can be filled with purpose through simple faithfulness.**

👉 *Our job is faithfulness. God's job is changing lives.*

## Read Together

- John 5:19
  - John 12:49
  - (Optional additional snapshots)
    - John 2:1–5 (Wedding at Cana)
    - John 3:1–2 (Nicodemus)
    - John 4:7–9 (Woman at the well)
    - John 19:28–30 (Crucifixion)
    - John 20:11–18 (Resurrection)

## Discuss (20–30 min)

### 1. Seeing Jesus' Faithfulness

- What stands out to you about how Jesus lived—“doing what the Father showed Him”?
- Which story (wedding, Nicodemus, Samaritan woman, cross, resurrection) most challenges or encourages you right now?
- Where do you see that Jesus was simply being faithful in the moment?

👉 *Follow-up:* How does that reshape what you think a “meaningful life” looks like?

## 2. Our Opportunity for Faithfulness

- The message said: *“Be where you’re supposed to be doing what you’re supposed to be doing.”*  
What do you think that looks like in real life?
  - Where are you tempted to chase outcomes instead of faithfulness?
  - Why do you think we tend to underestimate “small” acts of obedience?
- 

## 3. Faithfulness in the Ordinary

- Do you tend to see your daily life (work, home, routines) as meaningful or mundane? Why?
  - Where might God already be inviting you to be faithful that you’ve been overlooking?
  - What is one “ordinary” moment in your week that could actually be an opportunity for kingdom impact?

## 4. The Role of the Gospel

- How does Jesus’ death and resurrection make a life of faithfulness possible?
  - Why is it important that our purpose is rooted in what Jesus has already done—not what we accomplish?
  - How does believing *“my life has purpose”* change the way you approach your week?
- 

## Apply (10–15 min)

### Personal Reflection:

- Where is God calling me to simple faithfulness right now?

- What is one specific situation this week where I need to:
  - Show up
  - Pay attention
  - Obey what I know is right

**Action Step:**

👉 Identify **one moment this week** where you will intentionally be faithful (conversation, decision, act of kindness, obedience, etc.)

---

## Practice (Optional Spiritual Exercise)

**Daily Prayer (simple + repeatable):**

“Father, help me be where I’m supposed to be, doing what I’m supposed to be doing. I trust You with the results.”

Encourage the group to pray this each morning this week.

---

## Close in Prayer (5 min)

- Thank God for Jesus’ faithfulness (life, cross, resurrection)
- Ask for eyes to see everyday moments as meaningful
- Pray for courage to be faithful in specific situations mentioned
