## Walking in Love, living as Light

Ephesians 5:1-14 // October 3rd, 2021

## **DISCUSSION QUESTION**

Paul calls all Christians to imitate Christ and to walk in love. Imitation is a huge and normal part of human life because we all imitate something or someone. What are some of the specific ways the bible calls Christians to imitate Jesus?

As Christians we're called to walk in love, but there are a lot of differing views on what that term might mean. The good news about the bible is that it does not leave that open ended. Read verses 3-10 and list the outcomes of walking in love.

Pastor Chris posed a great question in his sermon, "Have we been imitating Jesus or someone else?" What other voices or creeds are you tempted to imitate and be formed by? What might be attractive about them?

The bible doesn't just say we're in the light, but that <u>we are Light</u>! Yet before we are to be light in a dark world, we are called to address the sin in our own hearts, by bringing it to the light. We can bring struggles into the light and be helped and help others press into Jesus. Our struggle doesn't define us, and we are never alone. When you look to Jesus, are you eager to confess sin to Him and to one another, why or why not? If not, it is good to know that in Christ, there is no condemnation, and Christ will always take us in.
