## CG LEADER'S DISCUSSION GUIDE

Open and close with prayer. Any notes below are to help lead the discussion and not provide the "right" answer in every case. Ample questions are provided, use as needed to lead the CG discussion.

### Into the Text (Read Nehemiah 2:11-20)

- What stands out to you from this narrative? What questions do you have? What are 1-2 things you find interesting?
- What types of opposition does Nehemiah face in these verses? How does he respond?

### Application

- What parts of your life do you feel are in need of renewal? (*Assessing the need* both individually and corporately.)
- How can your community group encourage one another in these areas?
- There is both internal and external opposition that Nehemiah faces in these verses. Where are you facing opposition in your life? (This can include areas of sin and spiritual warfare, relational struggles, and worldly opposition from the cultural context.)
- Where are some ways that God is calling you to use your gifts and serve others? (In the church community? In the city?)
- Who has God placed in your life that needs to be engaged with the good news of Jesus?
- How can you pray specifically for one another based off the discussion?
