The Christian Life

Ephesians 4:25-32 // September 26th, 2021

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

How is the Christian life altogether different from other religions such as Isalm or Buddhism? Religion focuses on the external, yet the Christian life focuses on the inner life; the regeneration the Holy Spirit does in our lives. When you think about your own life, how has God worked inwardly in your own life? In other words, how would you say God is growing you over the years from who once were and who you are now?

In the church, we will inevitably sin against one another. We will be tempted to hold grudges toward one another, gossip, slander, and other types of sins against one another. This would grieve God's heart, and delight Satan's. Yet Paul calls us to be angry yet not to sin. Why do you think Paul exhorts the Christians in Ephesus to pursue unity with one another?

Have you ever gone to someone, or someone gone to you, and reconciled a conflict with them? Has it ever gone well? If so, why do you think that was?

How can reconciliation with another Christian go well when we have the work of Jesus in mind? (Gospel doctrine + safety + time = Gospel Culture)
