- ❖ Read aloud Colossians chapter 1. You can use a Bible app such as "Bible YouVersion", or have several people read sections of chapter 1 aloud to the group.
- 1) In verses 4-5, Paul gives thanks for the Colossian believers' faith, love, and hope. What keeps our/my focus inward instead of on Jesus?
 What keeps our/my focus inward instead of on fellow believers in our church?
 What keeps our/my focus inward instead of on believers' heavenly destination?
 (Read 1John 5:13)
- 2) In verses 9-14, what all does Paul continually pray for the Colossians?
- Look over Paul's poem about Jesus in verses 15-20.
 Describe Jesus.
- 4) Now, as you look over verses 21-23, describe the Colossians and then yourself before Jesus and after Jesus.

Think about someone who needs Jesus. Please stop and lift them in prayer.

5) In verses 24-29, Paul redefines success by explaining that his suffering was "for the sake of his [Jesus's] body, which is the church." What might suffering for the sake of our brothers and sisters in Christ here at GTCOC look like?

GO DEEPER: Take time this week to read and meditate on (think about) the supremacy of Jesus in verses 15-20. Write your own poem, hymn, or short prayer honoring Jesus.
